

CHOOSE THE RIGHT LOCK

Kryptonite categorizes its bicycle security products by the location your bike will be locked, and how long you plan to leave it. (i.e. quick stop, couple of hours, all day, overnight).



KRYPTONITE'S SECURITY RATING

- 9-10 = ultimate security
- 7-8 = high security
- 4-6 = moderate security
- 1-3 = deterrent security

LOCK YOUR BIKE...

1

Place your bike against a well anchored object, like a pole or parking meter, with chaining facing out.

Remove your front wheel and place it by your rear wheel.



THE RIGHT WAY

U-Lock: Place U-Lock shackle around a fixed, immovable object and through both seat stays (if frame will allow) and the two wheels.



Chain: Wrap chain through both wheels, around the frame and around the pole or fixed object while taking away any chain slack. Attach chain to lock and secure shackle around bicycle frame.

For additional security, Kryptonite recommends using a double-looped cable with your U-lock. Place the U-lock shackle around the pole, your bike frame and through your rear wheel. Loop a cable around your front wheel, bike frame and onto your U-lock shackle.

- Register your keys or combination with us.
- Make sure to use Finish Line lubrication at least once a month. The areas of the lock you should focus on maintaining include the cylinder, deadbolts, u-shackle ends, or the lock-pin attached to cables.

LOCK UP . . . DO'S & DON'TS

DO'S

- Make sure bike cannot be lifted over the object it is locked to.
- Keep your bike locked at all times.
- Lock your bike in a well lit area.
- Position your lock with key hole facing down.
- Create a snug fit with wheels and frame so that there is little room in the U-portion of the lock for thief's tools.
- Always use your u-lock as the primary locking device.

DON'TS

- Lock your bike to itself, or to objects that can be easily cut.
- Lock your bike in the same area all the time.
- Position lock near the ground. Thieves can attempt to leverage or crush the lock.

Kryptonite recommends that you spend 10% of the total cost of your bike on security
